The M.A.T. is a 60 minute computerized test. It is imperative that you arrive on time. You may be asked to leave if you arrive after the starting time. Plan on the entire process taking approximately 2 hours. Your patience and cooperation are appreciated.

You must bring two pieces of identification with you:

1. A government issued picture I.D. (i.e. driver's license) OR a signed school photo I.D.
- AND**
2. **Your Social Security Card or another formal document that has your social security # and your name on it. Proof and confirmation of your social security # is mandatory!**

There is a 25 person limit for each testing. Of this total we can accommodate 5 students retaking the M.A.T. The first 25 registrants will be admitted. You are encouraged to register early.

CANDIDATES WHO HAVE TAKEN THE M.A.T. WITHIN THE LAST YEAR MUST BRING THEIR "RETEST ADMISSION TICKET" WHEN THEY REPORT FOR TESTING: CANDIDATES CANNOT BE ADMITTED TO THE TEST WITHOUT A RETEST ADMISSION TICKET.

If you cannot attend on your registered date, prior notification is necessary to move your registration to the next scheduled testing. You must call the Graduate Office by 12:00 noon on the Friday preceding the date. Office hours are Monday through Thursday 8:30 AM to 7:45 PM, Friday 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM.
