The Family and Consumer Sciences Education program prepares students to teach in elementary, middle and secondary schools or adult and vocational-technical programs; graduates are also prepared for careers in Cooperative Extension, business, government, and the non-profit sector. Clinical experiences and student teaching are required. The program meets the requirements for teacher certification as set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.
