**1 APPLICATION FORM** Please fill out the attached application form and send it along with your non-refundable \$35 check made out to Immaculata University. If you visit campus and fill out an application while visiting, we will waive your \$35 application fee.

**2 TRANSCRIPTS** Official transcript(s) must be sent directly to Immaculata from any and all secondary or post-secondary institutions you have attended. The transcript(s) must include courses currently in progress.

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** An official academic record along with an English translation evaluated by the World Education Service (WES) is required from every secondary or post-secondary school attended. The transcript(s) is considered to be official only if it is signed, stamped in color and sealed.

**3 RECOMMENDATIONS** Two letters of recommendation must be submitted in the application packet. Letters can be from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc.

**4 STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES** You must submit the official scores of the results of the SAT and/or ACT test. We use three scores of the SAT and the writing component of the ACT.

**TRANSFER STUDENTS** If you have completed fewer than 24 credits, you must also submit your SAT or ACT scores and your high school transcript.

**INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS** For students whose primary language is not English, you must submit the results from the Test of English as a Foreign Language exam (TOEFL) or the IELTS.

**5 ESSAY** You must submit an essay (minimum 250 words) on one of the following topics:

1. A significant person or event that has had an impact of your life
2. The major you want to pursue at Immaculata University and why
3. A topic of your choice

*\*There are specific essays for Nursing and Thomas Jefferson University programs (see inside).*

**6 PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY** (International Students Only) A certified bank statement must be submitted. If a bank statement is in the name of more than one person, each individual must submit a notarized affidavit of support. A statement of finances which shows proof that sufficient funds are available for all expenses for the school year with the signature of the person responsible is required.

**7 ROLLING ADMISSION** Immaculata University operates on a rolling admission policy. Once a student submits all of his/her documents as stated above, the file will be reviewed by an admission counselor and a decision rendered. Usual response time from application to decision is 3-4 weeks depending upon the time of year.

**8 THE COMMON APPLICATION** Immaculata University is a member of The Common Application. You have the option of applying to Immaculata University via The Common Application ([www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)). The Office of Admission does not favor submission of our own application versus The Common Application.

## PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS

Immaculata University offers partnership programs in Bioscience Technologies, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, and Radiologic Sciences with Jefferson College of Health Professions of Thomas Jefferson University. These programs require a specific track of coursework to prepare students to seamlessly matriculate into Jefferson College of Health Professions following three years of study at Immaculata University. A distinctive admission process exists for students wishing to study in these programs. The requirements shown below apply only to those students intending to participate in these programs.

### Admission Requirements

- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.2 or higher
- SAT score of 1650 or higher or ACT of 24 or higher
- On campus interview at Immaculata University

### Deadline

- All application materials are due no later than **December 15**

### Application Requirements

- Admission application including fee, unless waived
- Official secondary school transcript(s)
- Official SAT or ACT test scores
- Essay on which major you would like to pursue and why
- Activities Resumé
- Recommendation Letter
- Volunteer/Observation hours: OT and PT applicants should have 25 hours completed at the time of application in either an OT or PT facility. 50 hours are required by matriculation into Immaculata.

#### Admission Requirements

- Secondary school transcript with a GPA in the general range of 3.0 or higher with courses to include:
  - 3 years of Math including Algebra
  - 3 years of Science which must include 2 lab sciences including Chemistry
- Acceptable SAT/ACT scores are required
- 2 letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc.
- Essay on why you would like to pursue a career in Nursing
