

## How to Calculate a GPA (effective Fall 2006)

Grades and quality points at Immaculata University are:

Grades	Quality Points
A	4.00
A-	3.67
B+	3.33
B	3.00
B-	2.67
C+	2.33
C	2.00
C-	1.67
D+	1.33
D	1.00
F	0.00

A grade point average is the total quality points divided by the total credit hours. Note the example:

Grades	Credit Hours	Quality Points
A	3	4.00
B	4	3.00
B+	3	3.33
C-	2	1.67

To get the total quality points, multiply the quality points for each grade by the number of credits for the grade:

A	3	x	4.00	=	12.00
B	4	x	3.00	=	12.00
B+	3	x	3.33	=	9.99
C-	2	x	1.67	=	3.34
	---				-----
sum	12 gpa hrs		36.33 points		36.33 points/12 gpa hrs = 3.02 gpa

Note: If a course is repeated, the last grade earned will be used to compute the grade point average.
