

**College of Undergraduate Studies
Senior Survey, Class of 2010
Office of Institutional Research and Assessment**

In spring 2010 all 144 College of Undergraduate Studies graduates were given the ‘Senior Survey, Class of 2010’. Graduates were administered the survey on May 10, 2010 during commencement practice. Five \$25 Wawa gift certificates were raffled out to increase participation. All graduates were given the survey regardless of when they began at IU (as a freshmen or transfer). A total of 102 graduates completed the survey giving a response rate of 71 %. (2009 was 80%, 2008 was 74.5%)

The content of the survey was the result of a collaborative effort between the Vice-President for Academic Affairs, Vice-President for Student Affairs, Dean of Students, and the Dean of CUS. There was a conscience effort to have similar questions on the Senior Survey that are on other satisfaction assessments to allow for longitudinal data. Longitudinal data is provided where available.

**College of LifeLong Learning Exit Survey
2009-2010
Office of Institutional Research, Planning and Assessment**

The College of LifeLong Learning (CLL) conducted an Exit Survey of its August 2009, January 2010, and May 2010 graduates to assess the nontraditional undergraduates' perceptions of their Immaculata University experience. The survey was administered via hard-copy by CLL staff to those who attended graduation rehearsal on May 10, 2010. Surveys were mailed to graduating students who did not attend the rehearsal. All 509 CLL graduates for academic year 2009-2010 received a survey; 257 graduates completed the survey. The survey was only offered in hard copy. The response rate was 51% (2009 was 51% and 2008 was 52%). The Office of Institutional Research, Planning, and Assessment did the data entry and provided analysis for this report. All tables are arranged from highest to lowest scores.
