Admission Application

1 APPLICATION FORM Please fill out the attached application form and send it along with your non-refundable \$35 check made out to Immaculata University. If you visit campus and fill out an application while visiting, we will waive your \$35 application fee.

2 TRANSCRIPTS Official transcript(s) must be sent directly to Immaculata from any and all secondary or post-secondary institutions you have attended. The transcript(s) must include courses currently in progress.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS An official academic record along with an English translation evaluated by an official academic record along with any NACES approved transcript review organization. The transcript(s) is considered to be official only if it is signed, stamped in color and sealed.

CODE OF CONDUCT CERTIFICATE Transfer applicants that have attended a four-year institution must submit a "Conduct Certification Form" from each 4-year institution attended.

3 RECOMMENDATIONS One letter of recommendation must be submitted in the application packet. Letter can be from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc. Nursing applicants must submit two letters of recommendation.

4 STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES Applicants can now choose to have their application evaluated without submitting SAT/ACT scores. However, SAT/ACT scores are still required for applicants wishing to major in nursing, any allied health concentration, or the occupational therapy partnership program with Thomas Jefferson University. SAT/ACT scores are also required for consideration for our full-tuition Presidential Scholarship and for our Honors Program. We use three sections for the old SAT and the total score for the new SAT.

TRANSFER STUDENTS Please submit transcripts of all previous college coursework. If you have completed fewer than 24 credits, you must also submit your high school transcript. If you attended a four-year institution, please submit the conduct certification form found on our website.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS For students whose primary language is not English, you must submit the results from the Test of English as a Foreign Language exam (TOEFL) or the IELTS.

5 ESSAY You must submit an essay (minimum 250 words) on one of the following topics:

1. A significant person or event that has had an impact on your life
2. The major you want to pursue at Immaculata University and why
3. A topic of your choice

**There are specific essays for Nursing and Thomas Jefferson University programs (see back panel).*

6 PROOF OF FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY (International students only) A certified bank statement must be submitted. If a bank statement is in the name of more than one person, each individual must submit a notarized affidavit of support. You must also submit a statement of finances, which shows proof that sufficient funds are available for all expenses for the school year, with the signature of the person responsible.

7 ROLLING ADMISSION Immaculata University operates on a rolling admission policy. Once a student submits all of his/her documents as stated above, the file will be reviewed by an admission counselor and a decision rendered. Usual response time from application to decision is 3-4 weeks depending upon the time of year.

8 THE COMMON APPLICATION Immaculata University is a member of The Common Application. You have the option of applying to Immaculata University via The Common Application (www.commonapp.org). The Office of Admission does not favor submission of our own application versus The Common Application.

PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMS – FALL TERM APPLICANTS ONLY

Immaculata University offers partnership programs in Bioscience Technologies, Occupational Therapy and Radiologic Sciences with Jefferson College of Health Professions of Thomas Jefferson University (TJU). These programs require a specific track of coursework to prepare students to seamlessly matriculate into Jefferson College of Health Professions following three years of study at Immaculata University. A distinctive admission process exists for students wishing to study in these programs. The requirements shown below apply only to those students intending to participate in these programs.

Admission Requirements

- Cumulative high school GPA of 3.3 or higher
- Minimum old SAT score of 1780
- Minimum new SAT total of 1270 or higher
- or ACT of 26 or higher
- On-campus interview at Thomas Jefferson University

Deadline

- All application materials are due no later than **December 15**

Application Requirements

- Admission application including fee, unless waived
- Official secondary school transcript(s)
- Official SAT or ACT test scores
- Personal statement on why you want to attend TJU for Occupational Therapy
- Activities resume
- 2 letters of recommendation
- Volunteer/observation hours: OT applicants should have 25 hours completed in either an OT facility before the required interview.

Immaculata University's Nursing major has a distinct admission process.

Admission Requirements

- Secondary school transcript with a GPA in the general range of 3.0 or higher with courses to include:
 - 3 years of math including algebra
 - 3 years of science which must include 2 lab sciences including chemistry
- Acceptable SAT/ACT scores
- 2 letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc.
- Essay on why you would like to pursue a career in nursing
