

Position in Pacific University School of Professional Psychology
Assistant Professor (Tenure Track)

The School of Professional Psychology (SPP), Pacific University, located on the College of Health Professions campus in Hillsboro, Oregon, is seeking applicants for a tenure-track position at the Assistant Professor level beginning on July 1, 2012. SPP has an APA-accredited Clinical Psychology (Psy.D.) Program, its own Pacific Psychology Clinics (PPC), an APA-accredited Internship Training Program, and excellent hospital affiliations. The successful candidate must have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in clinical or counseling psychology and be licensed or license-eligible in Oregon. Preference will be given to applicants with expertise in child clinical psychology and/or a health-related focus, but outstanding candidates with other specialties will also be considered. Contracts within SPP are for an 11-month academic year. Duties will include teaching in the Psy.D Program, advising students, mentoring theses and dissertations, and pursuing an active program of research.
