Cultural & Linguistic Diversity

Program Hiatus:

Effective Spring 2017, the MA Cultural & Linguistic Diversity and TESOL Certificate/ESL Program Specialist Certificate programs have been placed on hiatus. No new students will be admitted into these programs. (Approved October 12, 2016)

Nutrition Education

Change Program Content and/or Structure:

Effective Fall 2017 - NED 689 Preparation for Nutrition Education Thesis (3 credits) and NED 690 Thesis Seminar in Nutrition Education (3 credits) will be replaced by NED 691 Nutrition Capstone (3 credits). Since there is no reduction in credits, the Concentration/Electives for each track has been redistributed as follows: (Approved November 2, 2016)

Dietetic Internship Program: -Concentration = 34 credits (Remove NED 689, 690 and add NED 691) -Electives = 5 credits

Registered Dietitian: -Concentration = 19 credits (moved NED 644 & 645 from elective to concentration; removed NED 689, 690 and add NED 691) -Electives = 11 credits

Wellness Promotion: -Concentration = 16 credits (Remove NED 689, 690 and add NED 691) -Electives = 14 credits

Graduate Psychology

New Doctoral Level Courses:

Effective Fall 2017 – The following doctoral level courses have replaced the master level courses in the Doctor of Psychology Degree in Clinical Psychology – PsyD (Approved February 2017)

PSYC 703 (3) – Tests & Measurements

(Replaces PSYC 663 – Psychometrics) This course explores theories and techniques of psychological measurement. Concepts of reliability and validity; classical and contemporary measurement theories; and test standardization processes will be examined. Qualitative and quantitative scale development strategies will be explored. Relevant laws and ethical principles will be reviewed. Open only to Psy.D. students in Clinical Psychology.

PSYC709 (3 cr) – Group Dynamics

(Replaces PSYC 604 – Group Process) Course includes group theory and member selection; ethics; group leadership; techniques for coping with group process and individual group members; diversity; application of concepts to organizational systems; role playing. Open only to Psy.D. students in Clinical Psychology.

PSYC 728 (3 cr) – Cognitive Clinical Assessment

(Replaces PSYC 664 – Assessment I: Cognitive)

Course covers administration, scoring, interpretation, and report writing in cognitive assessment. Primary focus on the Wechsler scales. Client-examiner relationship dynamics, and development of inferences from test content are integrated with structural analysis. Review of ethics, diversity, and decision-making across different clinical settings. Prerequisite PSYC 703. Open only to Psy.D. students in Clinical Psychology.



New Master Level Courses:

Effective Fall 2017 – Update Subject Code from PSYC to COUN for Clinical Mental Health Counseling Program. New course numbers include: COUN 517, 599, 604, 606, 608, 614, 617, 620, 630, 640, 641, 668, 669, 691, 692, 693.
