In <u>each</u> of the Subject Examinations listed, from 3 to 6 credits will be awarded provided that these Subject Examinations are in areas similar to those described in the college catalog. The total number of CLEP credits transferable may not exceed 63 semester hours.

Credit for examinations successfully attempted will be awarded by transcript entry for matriculated students. Since no grade is given, credits earned through CLEP transfer are not computed in the grade-point average. A \$10.00 transcription fee applies.
