The Wagoner Nursing Medal Award

Criteria for Nomination:

The **Wagoner Nursing Medal Award** is given annually by the Immaculata University Division of Nursing. The nominee for this award must be a graduating RN-BSN or ABSN student with a GPA of 3.5 and outstanding contributions to community service and the nursing profession. Student must be present at graduation in order to be awarded the Wagoner Nursing Medal. Applications will be evaluated by the Award Selection Committee.

Award Recognition:

The winner of this Award will be notified in March and is recognized at commencement.

Nomination Packet:

The nominated student is responsible for coordination and submission of all parts of the nomination packet. Completed nomination packets will have a deadline for receipt sometime in February. Incomplete nomination packets will not be considered.

Required Documentation for Consideration:

- ✓ Nomination form
- ✓ Students may self-nominate or be nominated by an IU faculty member.
- ✓ One letter of support (a faculty nomination will be considered a reference letter)
- ✓ An Essay (300 to 400 Words) from the *nominated candidate* which comments on his/her nursing philosophy and activities associated with service

The complete nomination packet will be submitted by a deadline stated by the Chair of the FSA (Faculty & Student Affairs) Committee within the Division of Nursing.

The forms that need to be completed – either self-nominations by the student or faculty nominations will be sent out via email when the call for nominations is sent by the Chair of the FSA Committee.
