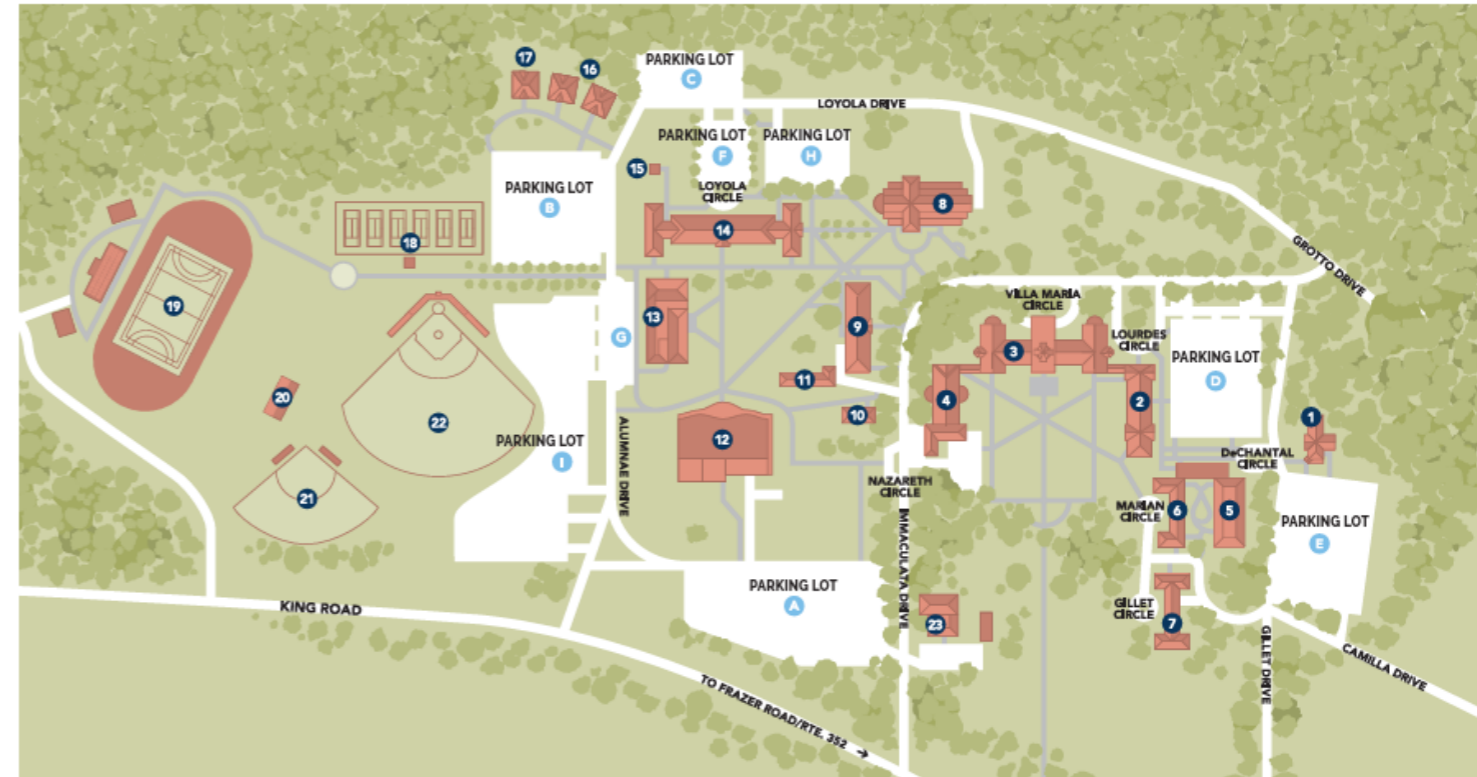


Parking & Arriving at Campus

For the two campus commencement ceremonies, all campus parking lots will be open for parking except for LOT G (passenger drop off point ONLY).

NO parking along roads or on grass!

- Use Alumnae Drive to access the Passenger Drop Off location (Lot G) as well as the parking lots closest to Alumnae Hall, the site of the Commencement ceremony.
- Use Immaculata Drive ONLY to access Parking Lot A from the east end of the parking lot.
- Use Gillet Drive to access Parking Lots D and E on the east side of campus.

Tickets

Students may pick up tickets:

- 8 AM to 4:30 PM on Wednesday and Thursday, May 13-14: Villa Maria Hall, Room 115 (first floor, across from the Board Room, near the Rotunda).
- The Academic Affairs office will be CLOSED Friday (in preparation for ceremonies).

DAY OF COMMENCEMENT, students may pick up tickets outside the Alumnae Hall large gym before their ceremony. Tickets will be available starting at check in time.

- **ONLY Graduating Students may pick up tickets.**
- **Graduates may leave tickets for family members at the Will Call table.**

Alumnae Hall Theater

ALL GUESTS, including children of any age, *must* have tickets to sit in the theater.

NO Exceptions.

No balloons allowed in Alumnae Hall Theater.

Theater doors open for guests at 8:45 AM.
Enter only through main doors.

Decorum: all graduates and guests are expected to maintain decorum throughout the ceremony.

Loyola Hall Viewing Area

Immaculata provides viewing stations for each ceremony in Loyola Hall.

- No tickets required.
- IU personnel on hand for questions.
- Convenient to quad for meeting up after the ceremony.
