# ADMISSION APPLICATION

- 1 APPLICATION FORM** Please fill out the attached application form and send it along with your non-refundable \$35 check made out to Immaculata University. If you visit campus and fill out an application while visiting, we will waive your \$35 application fee. Application fee is also waived during Instant Decision Days.
- 2 TRANSCRIPTS** Official transcript(s) must be sent directly to Immaculata from any and all secondary or post-secondary institutions you have attended. The transcript(s) must include courses currently in progress.
- 3 RECOMMENDATIONS** One letter of recommendation is required. Letters can be from a teacher, counselor, coach, employer, etc. Nursing applicants must submit two letters of recommendation.
- 4 STANDARDIZED TEST SCORES** Applicants can choose to have their application evaluated without submitting SAT/ACT scores. However, SAT/ACT scores are still required for applicants wishing to major in nursing, and any allied health concentration. SAT/ACT scores are also required for consideration for our full-tuition Presidential Scholarship and for our Honors Program.

**TRANSFER STUDENTS** Please submit transcripts of all previous college coursework. If you have completed fewer than 24 credits, you must also submit your high school transcript.

**CODE OF CONDUCT CERTIFICATE** Transfer applicants who have attended a four-year institution must submit a "Conduct Certification Form" from most-recently attended four-year institution.

- 5 ESSAY** You must submit an essay (minimum 250 words) on one of the following topics:
  1. A significant person or event that has had an impact on your life
  2. The major you want to pursue at Immaculata University and why
  3. A topic of your choice

\*There are specific essays for nursing programs (see back panel).

## INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

**Transcripts:** An official academic record with an English translation, along with any NACES approved course-by-course transcript evaluation. The transcript(s) is considered to be official only if it is signed, stamped in color and sealed.

**Standardized Test Scores:** For students applying from countries whose primary language is not English, you must submit the results from the Test of English as a Foreign Language exam (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS).

**Proof of Financial Responsibility:** Upon completing the application for admission, a certified bank statement must be submitted. If a bank statement is in the name of more than one person, each individual must submit a notarized affidavit of support. You must also submit a statement of finances, which shows proof that sufficient funds are available for all expenses for the school year, with the signature of the person responsible.

**ROLLING ADMISSION** Immaculata University operates on a rolling admission policy. Once a student submits all of his/her documents as stated above, the file will be reviewed by an admission counselor and a decision will be rendered. Usual response time from application to decision is 3-4 weeks depending upon the time of year.

**THE COMMON APPLICATION** Immaculata University is a member of The Common Application. You have the option of applying to Immaculata University via The Common Application ([www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org)). The Office of Admission does not favor submission of our own application versus The Common Application.
